Report on meeting with Aboriginal Catholic Ministry (ACM)

Date: Tuesday 6th October 2020 Present: Maree, Keegan, Dave and Fay Lisa Buxton, Fr Daryl Mackie, Kelly Wyld and Janice Bain

Mission of ACM: "To promote reconciliation and mutual understanding, taking care of Catholic Aborigines and supporting them in the living of their faith."

Main points:

- Would like to build a relationship with our parish. Interested in meeting parishioners at one of our Masses
- Highlight key dates in parish and School (Eg Reconciliation Week, NAIDOC etc)
- Invite the families who are identified Aborigines from school to take part in Masses of and other events of significance to Aboriginal people (eg NAIDOC)
- Importance of symbols in buildings to show welcome and acceptance (eg Aboriginal flag and Aboriginal symbols in Reception areas)
- Promote sale of Aboriginal crosses made by members of ACM (\$5 \$35)
- Promote ACM Confirmation Mass (Oct 25 at Kensington Monastry)

To mark **NAIDOC** at St Columba's, Social Justice Group members suggest:

- Acknowledgement of Country at start of each Mass
- Prayers of Faithful (2 or 3)
- Play recording of Aboriginal "Our Father" during Communion
- Display Aboriginal flag

NB NAIDOC is 8 – 15 November Theme: *Always Was, Always Will Be*
